

## Travel to Trowbridge

### **Rail and Road Travel.**

**Rail.** Trowbridge is on the main rail line between Cardiff, Bristol, and Portsmouth. From London Paddington travel to either Westbury or Swindon or Bath and change for Trowbridge.

From Birmingham and the North, change at Bristol.

From the South West travel to either Bristol or Westbury and change for Trowbridge.

From the South East travel from Brighton to Southampton and change for train to Trowbridge.

From Wales travel to Trowbridge directly on Portsmouth service from Cardiff, via Bristol and Bath.

**Note.** The Civic Centre is a 13-minute walk from the Railway Station along a flat route. There are also Taxis available too.

---

**Road.** From London take M4 then leave at junction 17 then travel south on A350. Then A361 to Trowbridge. Approximate journey time is 2 to 2 and a half hours.

From the North take M5 to junction 19 then M4 to junction 18, then A46 toward Bath then A4 before heading toward Bradford on Avon and Trowbridge.

From Wales take M4 to junction 18 then south on A46 to A4 before heading toward Bradford on Avon and Trowbridge.

**Note:** Trowbridge is approximately 18 miles south of the M4 from junctions 17 and 18. Approximate journey time from Birmingham is also 2 to 2 and a half hours.

**Parking.** Is adjacent to the Civic Centre at St Stephens Place Multi Storey Car Park. Please check on arrival as parking is free Mon – Sun for a 23 Hour max stay on levels 1a, 4a, 4b, 5a, 5b, 6a & 6b. The Civic Centre is across the road from the car park.

**By Bus** From London Victoria to Bath then Trowbridge by Bus or Rail.
